Get on I-40 E/I-85BUS N in Jefferson from E Gate City Blvd


- ↑ 1. Head east on W Market St toward N Greene St 9 min (4.4 mi)
- ↘ 2. Turn right onto Murrow Blvd 0.5 mi
- ↙ 3. Keep left to stay on Murrow Blvd 0.5 mi
- ↙ 4. Turn left at the 1st cross street onto E Gate City Blvd 207 ft
- ↑ 5. Continue onto E Lee St 2.8 mi
- ↑ 6. Use the left 2 lanes to turn left to merge onto I-40 E/I-85BUS N toward Burlington/Durham 0.3 mi



Follow I-40 E to NC-210 E in Rocky Point. Take exit 408 from I-40 E


- ↑ 7. Merge onto I-40 E/I-85BUS N 2 h 39 min (188 mi)
- [Continue to follow I-40 E](#) 34.1 mi


-  8. Keep right at the fork to stay on I-40 E, follow signs for Interstate 40/Raleigh

-  9. Use the right 2 lanes to take exit 289 for Wade Avenue toward I-440/US-1 N

-  10. Continue onto Wade Avenue
